OVERVIEW

A Product Owner represents the interests of the stakeholders in the Scrum Team. Commonly called 'the voice of the customer', the Product Owner is responsible for ensuring clear communication of product or service functionality requirements. The Product Owner also prioritizes the requirements from the point of view of an end user, for maximum business benefit, defines the Acceptance Criteria, and ensuring those criteria are met.

A Product Owner is accountable for defining & ensuring the right solution is delivered by using their skills as a vehicle for people, technology and process success. There are a number of skills that will contribute to the success of the Product Owner. The greatest test skill for the business analyst is the communication skills which include oral, written and listening skills. Another skill that is very important for the Product Owner is that of facilitation of stakeholders in all phases of the product development life cycle.
